They are very welcome to wear a swimming hat or rash vest, but this is not compulsory. If they have ear plugs for swimming, please make sure they can put them in themselves or let myself or Grace know if they need help. If you child is worried about swimming or is not confident in the water let me know and hopefully, we can help. Grace and I are both level 2 swimming instructors and will split each class into two groups to match each pupils learning. We are also able to teach in the water to help any worries. There will also be a pool lifeguard on duty for our session.

#### Safeguarding

This week, we have become aware of learners accessing inappropriate materials on home devices and bringing those materials into school. We have discussed with the learners that this is not appropriate and would be grateful if these conversations could also be had at home. Additionally, we would advise all families to check their level of security on all home devices (including phones) and ensure that learners are sufficiently protected. On the following pages, we have attached two guides that provide useful information for both iphone and Android devices.

## How to Set up PARENTA

**Android Phone** 



The settings on an Android device allow you to prescribe certain rules for when your child is using it. For example, you can block specific types of content to reduce the risk of your child being exposed to age-inappropriate material (music with explicit lyrics, for instance, and games, TV shows or movies that are unsuitable for young people). There are two ways to access parental controls on an Android phone: through Google Play or via the Google Family Link app. You can also lock your changes behind a PIN, so your child (or anyone else) can't change them back.






